Merkel, Rajan, Kerry, Ghani, Jindal, Trump, Stark and Blair are eight diplomats who represent eight different countries – Brazil, China, France, India, Russia, Spain, UK and USA – not necessarily in the given order. The eight diplomats are attending a conference to discuss some important issues concerning world peace. They are sitting at a square-shaped table, two on each side, as depicted in the figure given below. Please figure out their seating arrangement and the countries they represent based on the information below.

- 1. Jindal represents UK and is sitting at the third position to the left of Trump who represents Brazil.
- 2. Jindal and Ghani are sitting on the same side of the table.
- 3. Blair represents Russia.
- 4. Merkel, who represents France, is sitting between Trump and Kerry.
- 5. Rajan and Jindal are immediate neighbours.
- 6. Kerry represents USA and is sitting at the second position to the left of Rajan who represents India.
- 7. The person who represents China is a neighbour of Ghani.
